Campus Conference Facilities

MOSS ARTS CENTER

The Center for the Arts at Virginia Tech and the Institute for Creativity, Arts, and Technology are headquartered in the Moss Arts Center. The 150,000-square-foot facility includes a 1,260-seat performance hall, which would be ideal for plenary sessions.

NEW CLASSROOM BUILDING

Classroom Building contains 15 state-of-the-art classrooms and four interdisciplinary teaching laboratories with seats for more than 1,450 students, as well as study rooms and group meeting space. The new learning spaces are designed to support increasingly interactive and technology-driven learning experiences.

The classrooms have features that include moveable furnishings, wall-mounted writing spaces, and multiple screens for projecting shared material and student work. Some rooms were configured as SCALE-UP classrooms, a specific design that facilitates team-based, active learning as an alternative to lectures, even for large-enrollment classes.



ON-CAMPUS DINING

Virginia Tech has built a reputation for outstanding dining. Our dining program stays at the leading edge of national trends. Participants will have the option to purchase a campus dining plan that includes



breakfast, lunch and dinner at the following rates: breakfast - \$14.60, lunch - \$15.31, dinner - \$16.08. D2 is the designated on-campus dining facility that is open for summer conferences. D2 is an all-you-care-to-eat dining center offering a wide variety of food options including pasta, pizza, regional cuisine, grill items, vegetarian and vegan selections, salad bar, and a dessert bar.

OFF-CAMPUS DINING

Blacksburg is host to a wide variety of restaurants. The area surrounding Virginia Tech's campus boasts over 50 restaurants within walking distance, specializing in everything from burgers and fries to an eclectic variety of international cuisines at low to moderate price points. Travel & Transportation

AIR TRAVEL

Blacksburg is conveniently located 45 minutes from the Roanoke-Blacksburg Regional Airport (ROA). American, United and Delta airlines provide non-stop flights to five major US hubs. Ground transportation options from ROA include taxi service, rental cars and the Smart Way Bus service (see below for details).

Four international airports are located within 3-4 hours driving distance of Blacksburg: Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT), Dulles International Airport (IAD), Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU) and Piedmont Triad International Airport (GSO). A variety of rental car companies serve each of these airport locations.

Shuttle buses can be provided for participants who request transportation from the airport. Pick-up times will be posted on the conference website so participants can plan their arrival times accordingly.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The Smart Way Bus provides convenient transportation to and from the Roanoke-Blacksburg Regional Airport for only \$4 each way. Service runs continuously Monday-Saturday approximately 6 am-9 pm. Free wireless internet service is available while in transit.

Blacksburg's public transportation system, Blacksburg Transit ("BT"), has been recognized as an Outstanding Transit System by the American Public Transportation Association. Service is provided continuously throughout Blacksburg 7 am-10 pm Monday through Friday, 9:30 am-9:15 pm on Saturdays and 11:30 am-7:15 pm on Sundays. The fare is \$0.50 per ride or a monthly pass can be purchased for \$8. Buses are wi-fi equipped and handicap accessible. A free app is available to assist passengers in finding the nearest stop and selecting the appropriate route.

Eight bike share stations are located on the Virginia Tech campus. Riders download a mobile app, create an account and enter their account number to unlock a bike. Bikes can be returned to any dock in the area. Flexible pricing and timing options are available.







NEW RIVER JUNCTION TUBING

A lazy inner tube drift down a one-mile stretch of the New River provides the perfect escape from a hot summer day. A free shuttle bus will pick you up at Big Falls Park and take you back to the Junction so you can do it all again!

WONDER UNIVERSE: A CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Wonder Universe is a nonprofit children's museum located in Christiansburg, providing hands-on, inspiring learning opportunities for children that enhance their language, cognitive, motor and social development, while cultivating a lifelong love of learning.

FLOYD COUNTRY STORE; HOME OF THE FRIDAY NIGHT JAMBOREE

The Floyd Country Store is renowned as a place to experience authentic Appalachian music and dancing. Handmade local arts & crafts, preserves, soaps, lotions and books fill the shelves, along with a wide variety of items chosen with simple living in mind.

Local Attractions

HIKING

MCAFFE KNOB is one of the most photographed spots on the Appalachian Trail. Located near Salem, VA, the 7.7-mile loop trail features beautiful wild flowers and is rated moderate difficulty.

THE CASCADES is a highly scenic, 4-mile round-trip trail that meanders along a shaded mountain creek to a 66-foot waterfall within Jefferson National Forest. The trail is rated low to moderate difficulty. A picnicking area, accessible restrooms and a hydrant for filling water bottles are available at the park entrance.

GOLF

PETE DYE RIVER COURSE was Rated $4^1/2$ Stars by Golf Digest's "Best Places to Play," #9 on Golfweek's Best Campus Courses in America and #5 in Virginia by Golfweek's Best Courses to Play. Bordered by 2.5 miles of the scenic New River, the course provides a test of strategy and skills for golfers of every skill level. The River Course is home to the Virginia Tech and Radford University golf teams.

HANGING ROCK GOLF CLUB overlooks the beautiful Roanoke Valley and is surrounded by breathtaking natural beauty. The course, designed by Russell Breeden, offers a championship layout that guarantees golf enthusiasts of all skill levels a challenging and exciting round.

BREWERIES & WINERIES

In the past decade the Virginia Craft Beer scene has boomed from a handful of breweries to hundreds of brew houses across the Commonwealth. From Roanoke to Blacksburg and all along the I-81 corridor you'll find well-known breweries, including EASTERN DIVIDE BREWING, RISING SILO BREWERY, SINKLAND FARMS BREWERY, PARKWAY BREWING COMPANY, and many others.

Discover a passion for fine Virginia wine by first making your rounds in Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains. Wineries nearest Blacksburg include BELIVEAU ESTATE WINERY, CHATEAU MORRISETTE, and WHITE BARREL WINERY. Or take a short drive and explore one of the nearby wine trails: the WINE TRAIL OF BOTETOURT COUNTY, a scenic drive through the Blue Ridge Mountains that includes three family-run vineyards producing quality wines made with old-world techniques, and the BED-FORD WINE TRAIL, featuring six wineries, with beautiful views and picnic areas along the way.
